## Texas Adventure Ride

**The Texas Adventure Ride (TAR) is a 4 day dual sport adventure ride & rally that occurs each spring in Junction, TX. All motorcyclists are invited to attend.**

The Texas Hill Country and west Texas are full of great motorcycling roads. Though known for an abundance of twisty paved roads, the Texas hill country is also full of excellent dual sport roads. West Texas is no slouch in the roads category either, offering miles and miles of wonderful paved and unpaved roads and remote & scenic terrain.

Junction, TX is an ideal rally location. It is a large enough town to provide all the necessary resources for a rally (motels, restaurants, and other

services) without being too large, it's close enough for riders from east and north Texas to get here in a day or less, and, most important of all, it is located in the center of some superb dual sport riding.

This year's rally kicks off on Thursday evening, April 19th at the Best Western Hotel with rider check-in and social. Friday and Saturday are dedicated to riding during the day and tire kicking and story telling in the evening. Saturday night closes out the rally with a banquet, door prizes, and guest speaker.

## Texas Adventure Challenge

**For riders wanting a little more adventure or who enjoy a good challenge we present the inaugural Texas Adventure Challenge.**

Held in conjunction with the TAR (Texas Adventure Rally), this year's challenge is a 2-day

staged and timed rally event. Riders must complete each day's course as laid out and within the allotted time.

Each day's course will be 250-300 miles in length and consist of both dirt and paved roads, with an emphasis on including as much

dirt as possible.

This challenge is open to, and suitable for, any street legal dual sport adventure bike.

## Texas Adventure Ride (TAR)
